Fertilization

This application contains an organic based biological Meta-Catalyst. That will promote microbiological activity in the soil and plants that will promote a more robust ecosystem. The end result will produce a deeper, denser root system and stronger plant health.

Crabgrass Control

This is the most effective time to control crabgrass. Complete control is impossible because of climatic conditions and soil

disturbances. Ideally 80% control may be obtained by applying a pre-emergent treatment. Dethatching, aeration spiking or other operations will break this barrier and destroy the effectiveness of this treatment. It is best to avoid these operations until fall.

Service Calls

As a valued customer, your lawn problems are our lawn problems. That's why we offer service calls between visits at no additional charge to you. Please allow 2 weeks after an application for the result to be evident. Free service calls are available to 4 or 5 application customers only.

Mowing

Proper mowing height for this time of year is 2" to 2 1/2". In the spring mowing should be done frequently.

For best results we recommend not removing the clippings for 2 mowings after this treatment.

Grub Control Update

Recent studies have shown by applying grub control earlier, in late April, May and early June will increase its effectiveness. It will also control surface insects, mainly bluegrass billbugs. With this in mind, Late spring and Grub Control will be applied at the same time this year.

Snow Mold

With all the snow cover we have had this winter, we are seeing a lot of snow mold damage (caused by snow laying on unfrozen soil). These areas are matted and straw colored. Normally they will recover on their own, however a gentle raking of effected areas will speed up recovery.

Preventative Grub Control

Moles in the landscape

One of the most frequently asked question we receive is "what about the mole tunnels?".

Most homeowners are normally confused by all of the conflicting "advice" on mole control. You may believe that every rumor, home remedy, or control method is worth trying. However, this is normally unsuccessful. That's because the mole's primary food source is earthworms, and remedies like razor blades, castor oil or bubble gum have no effect on the mole.

Moles are 6 - 8 inches in length and weigh three to six ounces. There are six species, the Eastern mole is the most common in our area. Moles mate in March and normally have their litters in mid-April thru May. Each litter can have up to 6 young.



Remember the only effective way to control moles is by trapping. When we apply grub control, we are preventing the grubs from damaging your lawn, but not controlling moles as some may believe. If you would like to learn more about trapping, "themoleman.com" is a very good website
